my name is assaf and i was adiel's soldier in the "tsevet" of nov 99, but i would prefer to see my self as adiel's friend. i think we all do.

since November when we finished the military service, i live in Amsterdam, i work here as a security man for elal.

i bet you already heard it all about adiel, but i still want to you how great he was. first as an officer, and later as a friend. as an officer i have never met another one like him. he really really cared about us. it's really hard for me to translate that feeling to words (and in English too !) - but when i think of the time he was my "mafkats" - i can really feel it. at the time I'm not sure we fully knew what we had we just knew we had a good officer. but afterwards when time passed, and officers came and went, and there was no one to compare with Adiel's caring for us, his understanding, and his high goals that he set (for us as well as for himself). i remember the night when he told us he is leaving, he took us one by one to talk about the time he was with us. i told him he was a very good officer. he asked why. and i told him about that one time in the "orev" course, on Friday or Thursday, while we where all packing our things after a "shvua shteach" and dieing to get the hell out of that place near "mashabey sade" junc. everything was done, and we just sat beneath the trees, biding our time, telling jokes (i think we where the best tsevet in the "orev" in lazily biding spare and non spare time), adi came and asked us to pick up all the remains of cigarettts who were spread all over the place. first we thought he is just trying to mak us work instead of sit. but than he took a plastic bag and started picking up all the dirt. totally by him self. we couldn't sit anymore, and i think we picked the cigarette dirt for 30 years of "miluim" forces.

that was my story and he asked: "that's why you think i am a good officer" ? and said "yes". it had nothing to do with the army, guns, tactics, running fast or being tough. it was about taking a good look around you after evryone had sopped looking, and think what can you improve. how can you make it better. this is the material that wins wars, and wins peoples hearts as well.

you know, we were so undiceplened, the only one we listend to in 3 years of service was adiel.

later on as friends we talked a lot about how to live a different life. different than the ordinary lives. in one of his last e-mails he asked if i had a good advice for him, about what to do next year. the range of options moved from "ben gurion" university, to south america. i told him that my best advice is not to hurry. to do evrything in his own time.

i wish he could have some more time.
